HISTORIC LANDMARKS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

- I. **ROLL CALL** -- *Members Present: Beatty, Felter, McPherson, Stanton, and Sundberg. Staff: Mullen. Guests: Lisa Brown and Tim Royer.*
- II. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES** – *On a motion by Sundberg, a second by McPherson, and a 3-0-2 vote (Beatty and Felter abstain), the Minutes of March 3, 2011 were approved as presented.*
- III. **ORAL COMMUNICATIONS** – *None.*
- IV. **ANNOUNCEMENTS AND DISTRIBUTION OF LITERATURE** – *Felter mentioned attending a conference on home energy efficiency in Sacramento during last months' meeting. Sundberg noted that she would be participating in the "Big Time" event at HSU for the upcoming weekend.*
- V. **NEW BUSINESS**
  - A. HLC Training Module
    1. California Register Process; LDS Consideration – *The membership reviewed technical bulletins on the California Register process to which Chair Stanton elaborated on specific points. Beatty noted that the LDS Church yields distinctive character in terms of style, age, and materials. Sundberg questioned if a religious property can be nominated to the California Register; the membership observed that architectural style is an avenue for nominating religious properties. Lisa Brown presented information on George Cooper who was instrumental in the church construction. Chair Stanton provided additional research on Ted Pope who was the architect for the church. General discussion then ensued on the church location and its context. The membership then made the following motions:*
      - 1) Beatty Moved that after the review and discussion of additional historic information presented at the 4/7/11 meeting, the Historic Landmarks Committee has concluded that the LDS Church most probably meets at least three of the California Register listing criteria, those being criteria 2, 3, and 4. The Motion was Second by McPherson and Passed by a unanimous vote of 5-0.**
      - 2) Sundberg Moved that Chair Stanton draft a letter to the Planning Commission to clarify and explain the Committee's position that the LDS Church most probably meets the eligibility requirements of criteria 2, 3, and 4 of the California Register listing process. The Motion was Second by McPherson and Passed by a unanimous vote of 5-0.**
  - B. Review Draft Suggestions for Inkind One to One Replacements (Roofs) – *The membership volunteered to collaborate on rewriting the text to this handout and present the revisions at the May meeting.*
