The Committee on Democracy and Corporations consists of seven volunteer members who research options on how our community is taking action to control “pattern restaurants” from moving into downtown areas, cooperate with other communities that are working on socially responsible investing, advise the City Council on ways to promote “free and fair trade,” advise the City Council on ordinances and actions our community can take regarding corporations that have negative social and environmental impacts, and work to develop a policy that the City Council can implement to not do business with corporations that violate fair labor standards and/or environmental laws.
