The Open Space and Agriculture Committee serves in an advisory capacity to the City Council and City staff in regard to matters that relate to policies affecting open space. Members participate in the preparation and development of a detailed open space program to implement the open space and agriculture element of the General Plan and provide recommendations to the Council on the acquisition and/or protection of open space and agricultural lands. Members also provide recommendations to the Council for specific actions to take to secure open space. Members shall be selected for their interest, knowledge, or experience in active and passive recreation, fish and wildlife, land trusts, local agricultural farming, watershed management, wetland/riparian ecology and economic land use policy. The Open Space and Agriculture Committee holds regular meetings on the second Monday of every month at 6:00 p.m. and additionally as necessary.
